**MOX Project Donates Approximately \$30,000  
to the American Heart Association through Fundraiser**

AIKEN, S.C., March 10, 2014 –MOX project employees dug deep this year for the annual American Heart Association fundraiser raising \$29,573 for the charity and participated in the group's annual CSRA Heart Walk.

Over the past two months, employees have been holding bake sales, luncheons and other activities throughout the MOX complex to raise the money for this year's event. Private donations from employees also played a key role in exceeding this year's goal of \$12,000.

In addition, a large group of MOX employees, friends and family members participated in Saturday's CSRA Heart Walk on the North Augusta greenway.

Shaw AREVA MOX Services, LLC has a contract with the U.S. Department of Energy's National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA) to design, build and operate a facility to convert surplus nuclear weapon-grade plutonium into reactor fuel for use in commercial nuclear power plants. This work supports NNSA's nuclear nonproliferation program to eliminate nuclear weapon-grade plutonium in the U.S. Under a 2000 agreement, the United States and Russia will dispose of 68 metric tons of surplus plutonium, sufficient for approximately 17,000 nuclear weapons.
